Fees ... invoices and how to make your payments

Currently fees are £5.50 per hour. Invoices are issued termly and payment can be made by cheque, cash, BACS or Childcare Vouchers. For those children who are eligible for the Nursery Education Grant (the term after their child turns 3) https://www.stockport.gov.uk/funded-childcare-for-3-and-4-year-olds Pre-School will sort the relevant paperwork for you, all that is required from you is a signature. Some of you may be eligible for a further 15 hours funding a term too https://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk/

Uniform Don't wear anything precious ...

We have a Pre-School uniform which most of our children love to wear. As well as giving them a sense of identity it is also very practical! Sweatshirts cost £9 and polo shirts are £7.50 which can all be bought from Pre-School.

Morning sessions run from 9.15 - 12.15 Afternoon sessions run from 12.30 - 3.30 All day runs from 9.15 - 3.30

Under 3's we have 1 member of staff to every 4 children and over 3's we have 1 member of staff to every 8 children.
