FUNDING FROM JAN 24

Free education and childcare for 2-year-olds is for children who live in families on certain benefits, are looked after or in receipt of Disability Living allowance. They are eligible for a maximum of 15 hours per week for 38 weeks of the year. Children can start to receive funding straight away from when they receive a government code providing they have already had a 2nd birthday.

15 hours free childcare for 3 and 4-year-olds 15 hours per week funding for 38 weeks of the year is for ALL children aged 3&4 and DOES NOT need any eligibility criteria. 30 hours funding however is for 3&4 year old children of working parents subject to meeting eligibility criteria. They can have an additional 15 hours funded. Parents need to get a 11 digit code which begins 500 from Childcare Choices and renew regularly to remain eligible. All 3&4 year old funding can be accessed THE TERM AFTER the child's 3rd birthday

From April 2024

2 Year old children of working parents will be eligible for up to 15 hours a week x 38 weeks of funded childcare, subject to meeting eligibility criteria (the same as for 30 hours). Eligible from the term AFTER THEIR 2 YEAR old birthday.

Parents can access their codes from the **Childcare Choices** website from 2.1.24.

WITH BOTH THE 3&4 AND 2 YEAR FUNDING YOU MUST RECHECK ELIGIBILITY WHEN PROMPTED FROM HMRC, THIS IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY.

From September 2024

Children from 9 months old will be eligible for up to 15 hours a week X 38 weeks of funded childcare however this will not apply to Pre-School children.

From September 2025

Eligibility will increase to up to 30 hours funded childcare for Funding for ALL children of working parents from 9 months and above. More details will be released on this over time.
